Mission to Sarajewo, Bosnia and Herzegowina 24 May to 30 May 2008

Purpose of the mission: support to draw a veterinary medicinal products act

On the first day there was a short introduction by the interpreter into a draft of a veterinary drug law of Bosnia and Herzegowina, but unfortunately actually it was not available in English.

To check if it is usable for starting a transposition of it should be available in English, this was only at the end of the mission.

I designed a list which can be used as a list of concordance for the EU-legislation (Directive 2001/82EC of the European Parliament and the Council of 6 November 2001 on the Community Code relating to veterinary medicinal products, amended by Directive 2004/28/EG of the European Parliament and of the Council) .

Day 2: completing the list for the part of the Directive which can be the basis for further discussions and transposition into the BiH-legislation.

Day 3: Starting a introductory discussions concerning the Directive and the need for the BiH law on veterinary medicinal products with Slobadanka Cekic and Jasmina Matic.

Drafting a structure for a proposal for a drug law

Day 4: Continuing the discussions on contents of the Directive. Slobadanka gave the information that there are some bylaws which may be important in the field of veterinary medicinal products concerning e.g. authorization of manufacturers or controls. The list was only available in BiH language.

Day 5: Continue to draft a structure for a BiH drug law .

Conclusions: Actually there is no act for veterinary medicinal products available in BiH. A law has to be drafted which meets the Directive 2001/82/EC on veterinary medicinal products. The time of this mission was too short to go into the details. Do construct a legislation on this matter more important information from the beneficiary's side is needed concerning

- distribution of veterinary medicinal products
- who is allowed to distribute and administer veterinary medicinal products
- status of authorization of veterinary medicinal products
- from where are the medicinal products imported
- how is the situation concerning medicated feedingstuff
- structure of the veterinary administration

As a basis to continue and complete the act more detailed information about the situation in the field of veterinary medicinal products is needed.

Recommendation: to continue with this work to transpose the EU-legislation into the legislation of BiH much more input from the veterinarian side is urgently requested.

also support from the veterinary side who is concerned with this matter and also the side of the legal services.

For further discussions it is also important for the BiH side to have an understanding for the EU-Legislation in this field.

For this an introduction into the EU-legislation should be given for those who are concerned with the legislation in the field of veterinary medicinal products.

.To continue the work on this matter an Expert from an EU-Memberstate should be supported by at least a veterinarian and a lawyer from the BiH side.

As a basis for further work the attached proposal for a rough draft of a law on veterinary medicinal products should be used. The attached list of concordance may be helpful.
